PERSONAL SAFETY

BASIC PROTECTIVE MEASURES

Stay alert and aware of your surroundings at all times

Have plan and trust your instincts

There is safety in numbers

Tell a loved one or a friend where you are going and when you expect to return

Carry a fully-charged cell phone

Wear shoes and clothing that do not restrict movement

Know the locations of police & fire stations and hospitals

Be mindful of what you share on social media

Consider taking a self-defense class

IN YOUR CAR

Always lock your car

Keep windows up and doors locked while driving

Park in well-lit public areas

Stick to well-traveled streets

Have your keys in your hand before you get to your car

If you think you are being pulled over, use a well-lit public area

If you think you are being followed, do not go home, drive to the nearest police station

Do not engage in road rage incidents

WHILE PUMPING GAS

Shut off your engine and place valuables on the passenger side floorboard

Close your windows, lock your doors and take your keys with you

Stay vigilant of your surroundings the entire time

WHILE USING AN ATM

Use the ATM during daylight hours

Use the drive-up ATM, if possible

Be ready to do business. Have your card and paperwork in your hand

Remain observant

Leave immediately – do not count money outside or in your car

RIDESHARING

Do not use a rideshare if you are under the influence of alcohol

Verify the make and model of the vehicle and confirm the license plate number

Ask the driver their name before getting in the car

Try to sit behind the driver

Track the route so you know where you are going

IN YOUR HOME

Install exterior motion sensor lighting and cameras

Keep more than one light on inside your home at night

Close the blinds at night

Keep shrubs and trees trimmed

Keep overhead and exterior garage doors closed at all times

Keep windows and doors locked

Never hide keys outside

Secure sliding glass doors and windows with auxiliary locks or pins

Use deadbolt locks, solid doors, sturdy hinges and peepholes

Be cautious of door-to-door salesmen and service personnel

Do not open your door to strangers and do not let anyone inside

Keep valuables in a safe place, not the master bedroom

Be alert to suspicious persons and activity in your neighborhood and report it to law enforcement
